NYS Public Accountancy

To become a licensed Certified Public Accountant (CPA), you must first pass the Uniform CPA Examination ®. The CPA Exam consists of four, four-hour sections: Auditing and Attestation (AUD), Business Environment and Concepts (BEC), Financial Accounting and Reporting (FAR) and Regulation (REG). You must pass all four sections within 18 months, earning a minimum score of 75 on each part.

AICPA

Most states/jurisdictions require at least a bachelor's degree to be eligible to become a CPA. Learn more about educational requirements. As for experience, most states/jurisdictions require at least two years public accounting experience.

CPA Licensure

CPE is required for CPAs to maintain their professional competence and provide quality professional services. CPAs are responsible for complying with all applicable CPE requirements, rules and regulations of state boards of accountancy, as well as those of membership associations and other professional organizations.

Continuing Professional Education (CPE) Requirements for ...

A CPA is a certified public accountant and is licensed by the state. In California, to earn the prestige associated with the CPA license, individuals are required to demonstrate their knowledge and competence by passing the Uniform CPA Exam, meeting high educational standards and completing a specified amount of general accounting experience.

CPA Requirements - CalCPA
